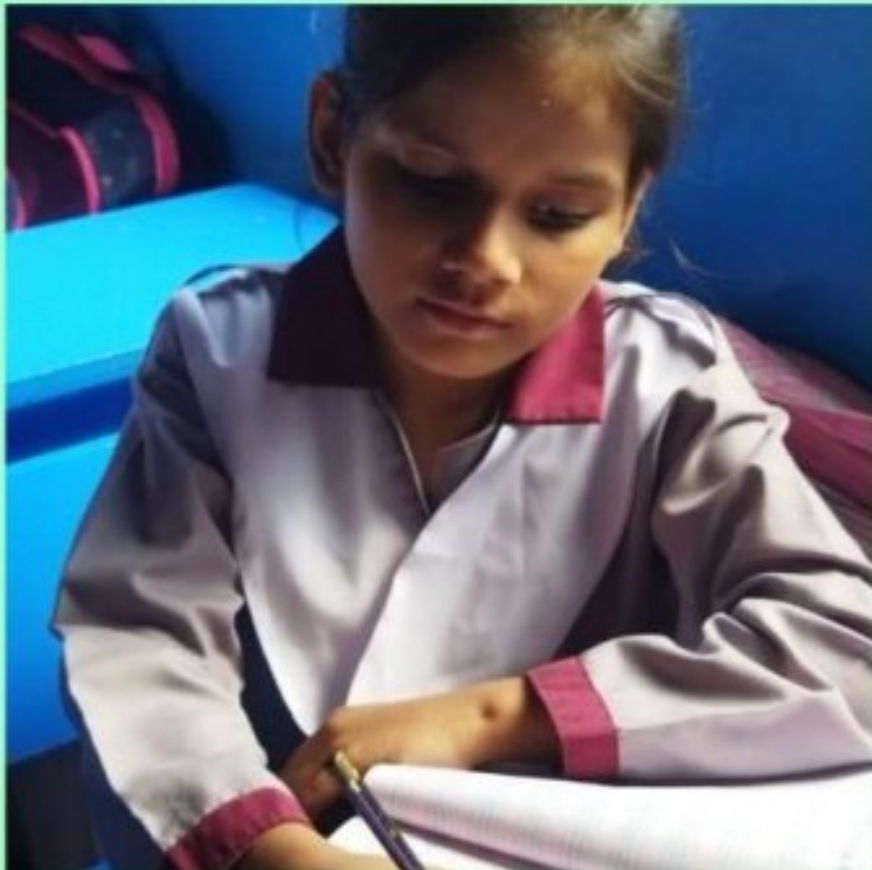


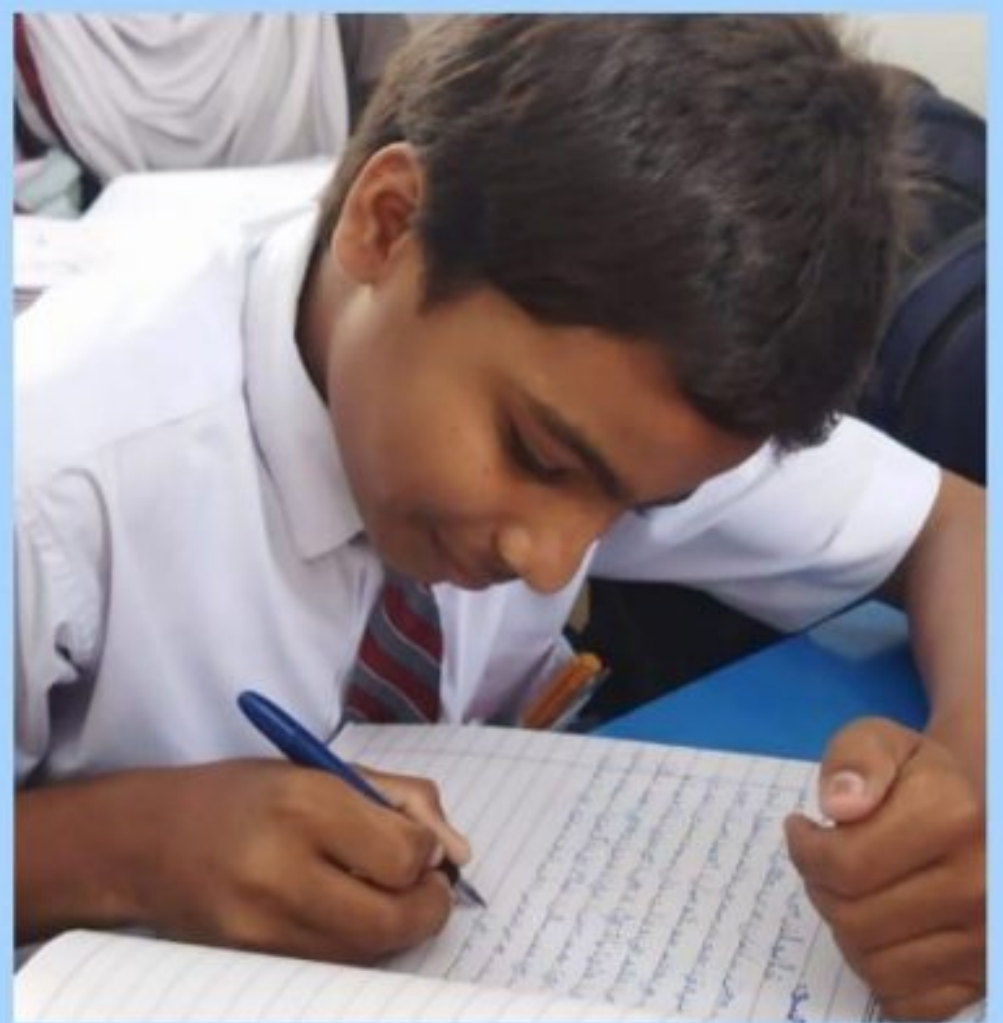
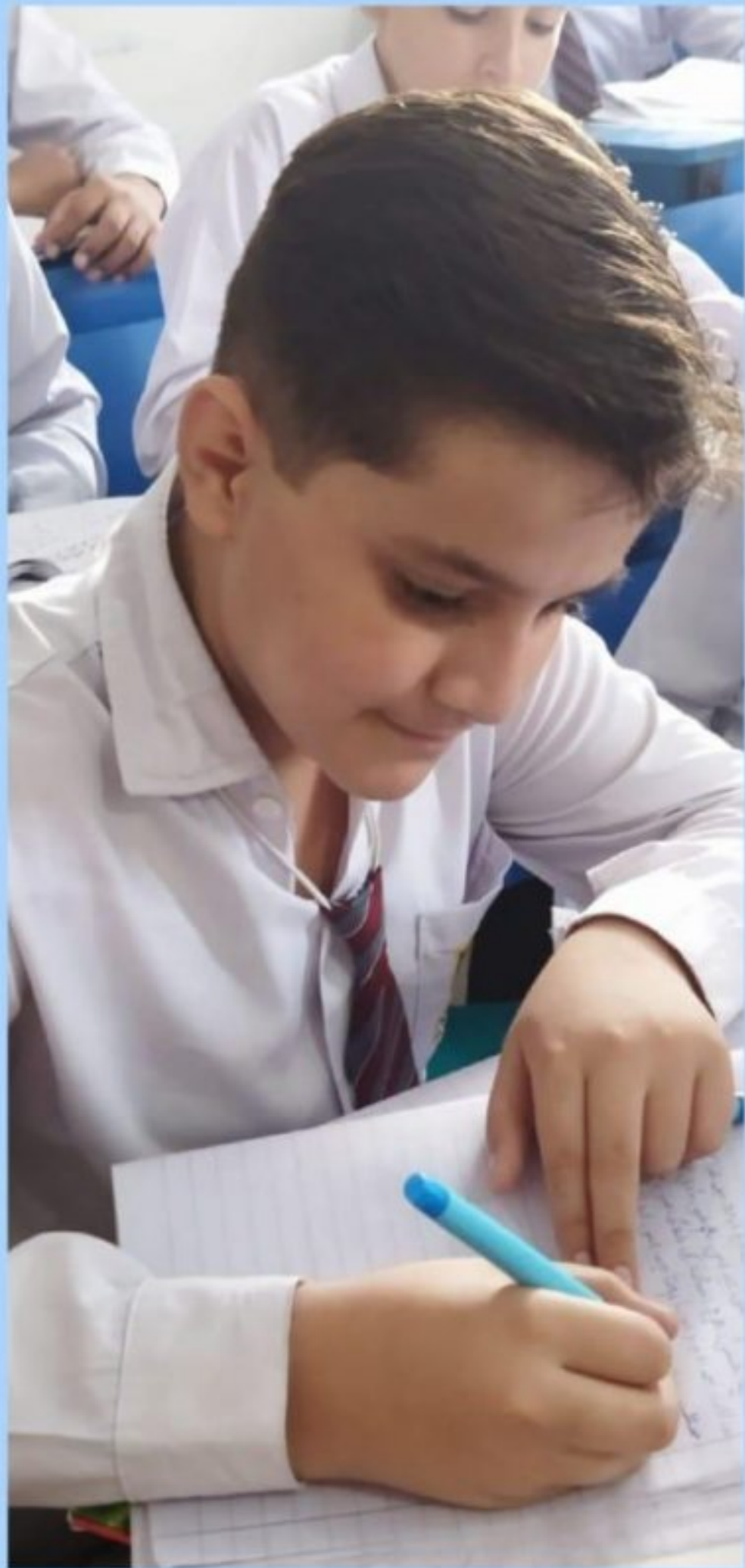
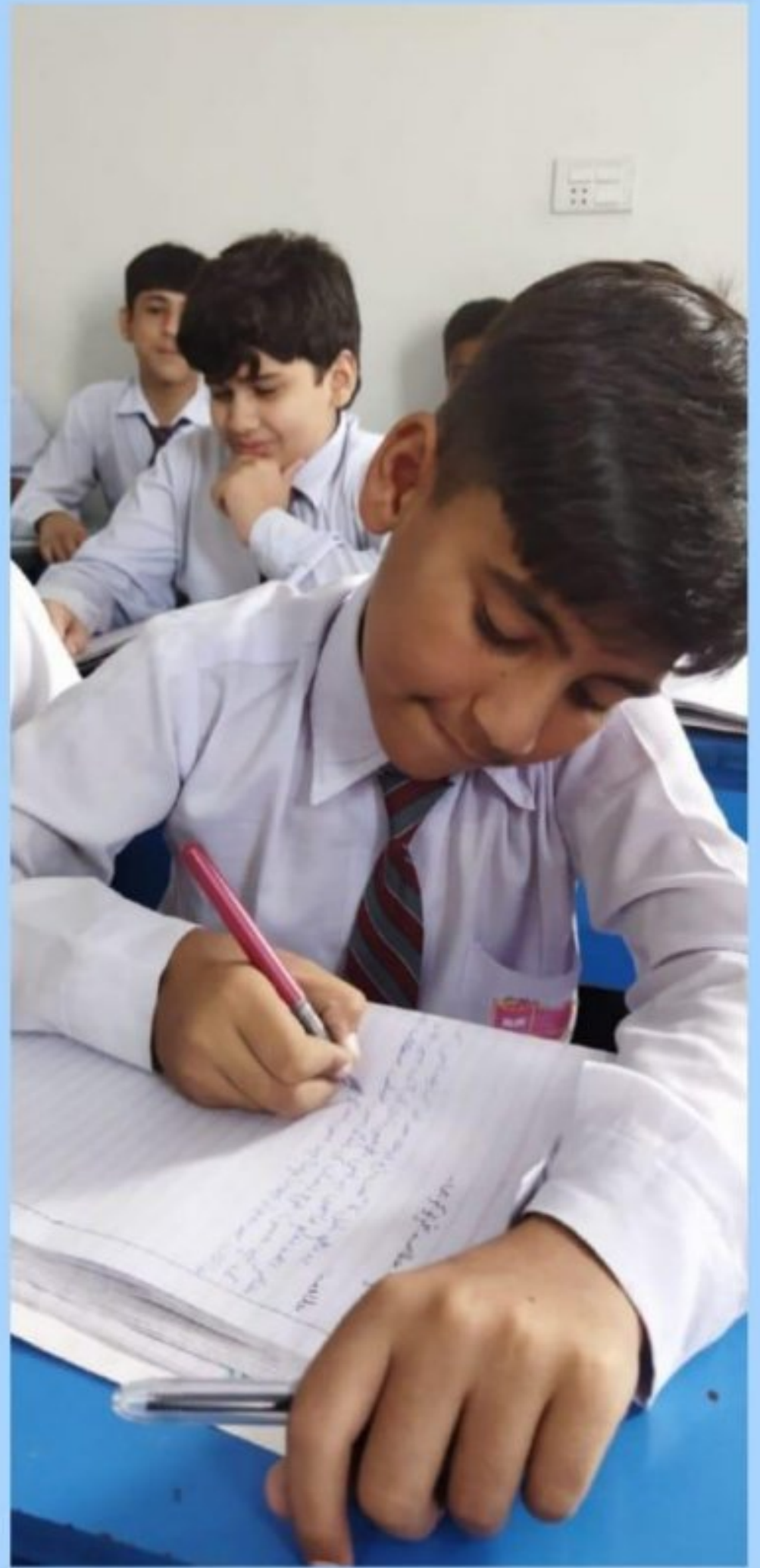
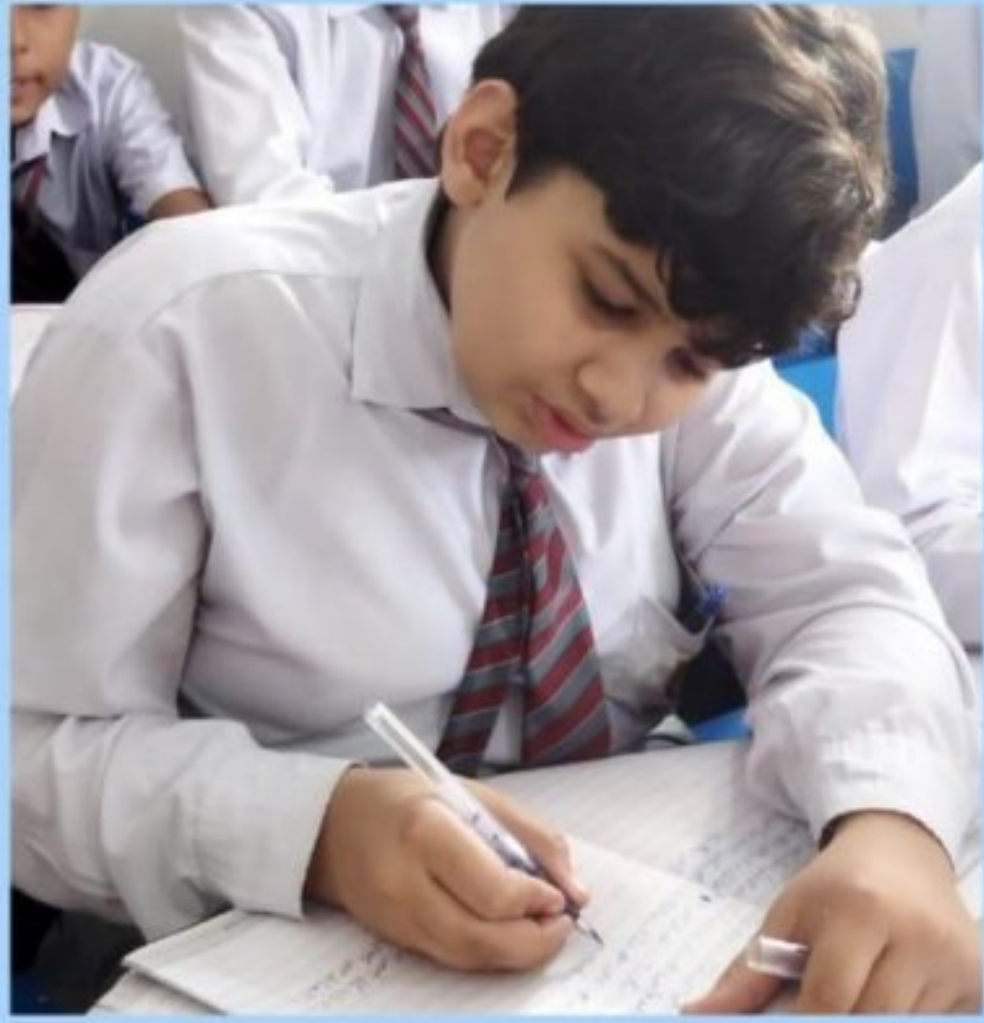
Introduction
